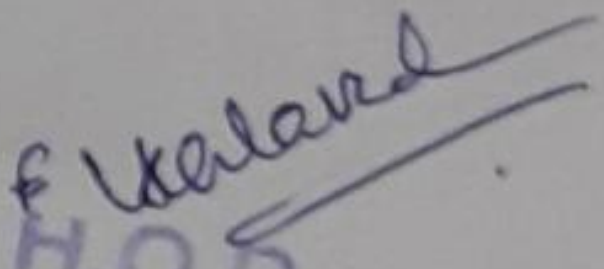
1.Total 19 Patients were examined for BSL maximum i.e. 17 patients were having BSL within normal limit. and 02 were having raised BSL advised further treatment
