

Description:-

Drug is an important and integral part and basic pillar of Treatment. So to understand Ayurvedic Medicine is very important. Pharmacovigilance is a science of collecting, monitoring, researching, assessing and evaluating information from health care providers and patients on the adverse effects of medications, biological products, herbal and traditional medicines with a view to identify new information about hazards associated with medicines preventing harm to patients. To give basic knowledge of these concepts and the present status of Pharmacovigilance in India and at international level "Workshop on Concept of Pharmacovigilance for Internees" was organized by Institutional Pharmacovigilance Cell.

Initially permission from Principal Sir was taken for this event and notice was given to Internee students of our Institute. For this Workshop total 32 internee were registered. After registration process the workshop was started at 10.00 am. The Resource person was the coordinator of Institutional Pharmacovigilance Cell. Dr Mahesh Inamdar. The workshop was conducted under three headings as General introduction of Concept Pharmacovigilance, Current situation of Pharmacovigilance in India and Concept of Pharmacovigilance in Ayurveda. The internees were given information regarding introduction, definition, need and ultimate goals of Pharmacovigilance, concept of ADRs and ADE, Governing bodies. The students were also made aware about historical background of this concept, various Pharmacovigilance centers in India, Pharmacovigilance of medical devices, Herbal medicines. The speaker Dr Inamdar sir gave information about National Pharmacovigilance programme for ASU drugs. The knowledge regarding ADR Reporting culture also given to Internees. Dr Inamdar sir gave various references in Ayurveda which shows similarities with Adverse Drug Reactions. Discussion was also carried out on need of Pharmacovigilance for Ayurvedic medicines, Herbal dugs, Herbs with Adverse Drug interactions. The Resource person discussed the challenges in introducing Pharmacovigilance in Ayurveda. Lastly Question and Answer session was conducted and feedback was taken from Internees. Dr Mahesh Inamdar smoothly conducted the workshop.
